### **Tet - The Vietnamese Lunar New Year**

Tet, or the Vietnamese Lunar New Year, is the most important and widely celebrated festival in Vietnam. It usually takes place between late January and mid-February, depending on the lunar calendar. Tet marks the arrival of spring and is a time for family reunions, honoring ancestors, and welcoming a new year full of luck and prosperity.
