Water pollution can be caused by a variety of things. Firstly, sewage is dumped directly into the seas without being treated properly. This is a global problem, with equally **significant** challenges in high-, middle-, and low-income countries. Sewage pollution has reduced the water quality and posed several threats to human health.
