Many scientists believe that people will live on other planets in the future, but not on one of the planets in our system.

We cannot live on the four outer planets, Jupiter, Saturn, Neptune and Uranus, because they are large balls of gas.

The four inner planets, including the Earth, are made of rock, so it is possible to land spaceships on Mercury, Mars and Venus. At some time in the future, spaceships might be able to travel the huge distances in an astronaut's lifetime, or perhaps people could go into something like a freezer while the journey happened. However, the average temperature on both Venus and Mercury is much too high for human life.

Mars has a very thin atmosphere, and this is why there is no water on the surface except in the form of ice. A thick atmosphere like the Earth's keeps water on the surface in rivers and oceans and near the surface of a planet in the form of rain. Venus has the opposite problem with its atmosphere. It is very heavy, so it pushes down on the surface with about 100 times the strength of the Earth's atmosphere.
