Instead of buying books and movies, borrow them or rent them. When you are shopping, buy reusable items, such as refillable pens, or rechargeable batteries. Second, reuse. You should take a reusable water bottle to school instead of a plastic one. Use both sides of the paper whenever you can. Third, recycle. Before you throw something away, check to see if it can be recycled. For example, you can wrap presents with used papers. Practice three R's and save the environment!
