B. GRAMMAR:

I. COMPOUND SENTENCES (CÂU GHÉP):

Câu ghép (compound sentences) là dạng câu được hình thành bởi 2 hoặc nhiều mệnh đề độc lập. Các mệnh đề này được nối với nhau bởi các liên từ (Conjunction).

Mệnh đề + LIÊN TỪ + Mệnh đề

* Các liên từ (conjunction) thường gặp:

For : Bởi vì => Dùng để chỉ nguyên nhân

And : Và => Dùng để thêm ý kiến

Nor : Cũng không => Dùng để bổ sung một ý kiến phủ định

But : Nhưng => Dùng để chỉ sự trái ngược

Or : Hoặc => Dùng để chỉ sự lựa chọn

Yet : Nhưng => Dùng để chỉ ý kiến trái ngược

So : Vậy nên => Dùng để nói về kết quả

Ví dụ:

- Her family planned to travel this summer, *but* the father was sick. (Họ đã định đi du lịch mùa hè này nhưng người cha lại bị ốm.)
- Nam's house is very old, *so* he is going to move to a new apartment. (Ngôi nhà của Nam rất cũ kĩ nên anh ấy sẽ chuyển đến một nhà chung cư mới.)
- My son wants to have a puppy for her birthday, *for* dogs is very cute. (Con trai tôi muốn một chú chó con cho ngày sinh nhật, vì chó rất đáng yêu.)
- My brother is a doctor, *and* my sister is a nurse. (Anh của tôi là một bác sĩ và chị của tôi là một y tá.)
- We don't go out, *nor* we don't want to do anything on the weekend. (Chúng tôi không ra ngoài và chúng tôi cũng không muốn là bất kỳ điều gì vào cuối tuần.)
- You should call her back, *or* she comes here to talk to you. (Bạn nên gọi lại cho cô ấy hoặc cô ấy sẽ đến đây để nói chuyện với bạn.)
- My children don't like vegetables, *yet* they eat them anyway. (Con của tôi không thích ăn rau củ, nhưng dù sao thì chúng vẫn ăn.)
