Sturgeon and paddlefish - freshwater fish have existed for hundreds of millions of years - now face extinction mainly (21) the illegal trade in wild-caught caviar and meat. The world's first comprehensive assessment of the species in over 13 years, released today by the International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN), confirmed that all 26 remaining species are now threatened with extinction.
