AI has developed dramatically in the last decade, which raises a serious concern that AI will **take over** many jobs soon. However, some scientists believe that AI will be more helpful than threatening for several jobs.

AI is ideal for tasks that can be highly dangerous for humans. Risky occupations, such as firefighters and soldiers, will be performed by AI robots in the future. Additionally, some jobs are extremely exhausting and dull, but AI robots are excellent for repetitive tasks since **they** never become bored or demand regular breaks with water and food. This implies that AI will certainly take over basic jobs such as factory work or cleaning.

AI can be rapidly programmed for tasks that demand a significant amount of knowledge and could take people years of training, such as computer programming or banking. However, not all challenging jobs can be **executed** by AI. Some require more than just intelligence. For instance, being a doctor requires both possessing extensive knowledge and being sensitive to human emotions. AI can assist with the treatment and prescription, but it cannot completely replace human doctors.

Finally, some jobs involve different types of emotions and building connections with people, and AI cannot be applied to this type of work. AI can sound cheerful and courteous when it communicates, but it cannot feel or react to human complicated emotions because it doesn't have EQ (Emotional Quotient or Emotional Intelligence). Occupations like counselors or social workers demand true human emotions. This kind of work requires far more soft skills than merely sounding friendly, so AI is not useful in those jobs.
