AI has developed dramatically in the last decade, which raises a serious concern that AI will take over many jobs soon. However, some scientists believe that AI will be more helpful than threatening for several jobs.

AI is ideal for tasks that can be highly dangerous for humans. Risky occupations, such as firefighters and soldiers, will be performed by AI robots in the future. Additionally, some jobs are extremely exhausting and dull, but AI robots are excellent for repetitive tasks since they never become bored or demand regular breaks with water and food. In summary, AI will be employed in such various ways that it will enhance human lives and simplify professional tasks. People should be fully aware of the benefits of AI so that they can make the best use of it.
