Positive form (Thể khẳng định)	S + will + V_(nguyên thể) Example: I will buy a bicycle soon.
Negative form (Thể phủ định)	S + will + not + V_(nguyên thể) Example: I won't give up my dream
Question form (Thể nghi vấn)	Will + S + V_(nguyên thể)? Trả lời: Yes, S + will/ No, S + won't Example: Will they build houses in outer space? Yes, they will

✚ Dấu hiệu nhận biết

Trong câu thường có các từ sau: **soon/ tomorrow/ in the future/ next week/ month/ year.../ this afternoon/ week/ month.../ probably/ maybe, perhaps/ someday.**

Ex: The bus will come **soon**.

Ex: There won't be anything new **tomorrow**.

II. Modal verb "Might"

✚ Trọng âm của từ hai âm tiết

Nguyên tắc chung

Trọng âm sẽ nhấn vào âm thứ hai nếu:
+ Âm tiết thứ hai của từ chứa 1 **nguyên âm dài hoặc một nguyên âm đôi**
+ Hoặc kết thúc bằng **hai phụ âm trở lên**
E.g: ac'count, a'dapt, a'mongst, be'fore, be'side, ...

Động từ hai âm tiết thì trọng âm rơi vào âm tiết thứ hai.
E.g: re'lax, ob'ject, re'ceive, ex'plain
Ngoại lệ: Nếu động từ chứa **nguyên âm ngắn ở âm tiết thứ hai** và kết thúc bằng **một phụ âm** (hoặc không kết thúc bằng một âm) thì trọng âm rơi vào âm tiết thứ nhất.
E.g: 'visit, 'enter, 'open

Danh từ và tính từ hai âm tiết thì trọng âm rơi vào âm tiết thứ nhất.



