Traditional children's games in Britain

Marbles are small balls made of glass. Children put some of them in a circle which was drawn on the ground. Then they tried to hit each other's marbles out of the circle. You can still buy marbles in some British shops, but the game is not popular today.

Stick and hoop was a game in which children pushed a hoop – a circle of wood – along the ground with a stick, trying to keep it rolling without falling. This simple game is never seen nowadays.
