The government of Vietnam has been taking important steps to protect endangered species in recent years. With over 10,000 species at risk in the country, it is crucial to address the growing threats that these animals face. Some of the most endangered species include the Indochinese tiger, the black-shanked douc, and the Saola, a rare wild ox that was first discovered in the Annamite Mountains. The government has implemented several measures to protect wildlife, such as creating national parks and wildlife **sanctuaries**, along with stronger wildlife laws.

One of the most significant actions has been the establishment of the "Forest Protection and Development Program," **which** aims to conserve and restore natural habitats for endangered species. Additionally, Vietnam has signed international agreements to combat illegal wildlife trade. Authorities now work more closely with non-governmental organizations (NGOs) and conservationists to monitor endangered species and enforce environmental regulations.

To raise awareness among the public, the Vietnamese government has launched educational campaigns on the importance of preserving wildlife. These programs emphasize the role of biodiversity in maintaining ecological balance and highlight the need to protect animals that are vital to the environment.
