In Finland we do give homework, but it is only given when the teacher feels that it is necessary for the students. There is no policy that homework has to be given after every lesson, or even every week.

The aim of homework is to give the student a possibility to do revision on a new topic or the most important topics covered in class. Homework should not be about learning anything new at home, but more about challenging the student's memory on what concept was covered in class. In this task the student would have to think about what they learned in school and how to adapt that information into their homework. The teacher should not give the student tasks where they need to learn anything new.

Because the aim of homework is only to do revision on the most important concepts covered in class, homework shouldn't take over 15 minutes per subject. Teachers need to **keep in mind** that students have on average 4-5 different subjects per day. If every teacher gives **them** 30 minutes of homework, that would be over 2 hours of extra studying each night.

The Finnish education system wants to make sure that students have the ability to recharge from their school day by doing non-school related things that make them happy. For example, participating in football training, playing the piano, and enjoying time with their friends. This is why we limit the amount of homework. Studenst have time to relax after school, they feel **rested** and have

full focus and motivation for their next work day at school.
