Ngoại lệ: Một số từ có đuôi "ly" nhưng là tính từ: daily: hàng ngày, early: sóm; elderly: già, lớn tuổi; friendly: thân thiện, likely: có khả năng sẽ xảy ra; costly = đắt đỏ; lively = sinh động, lonely lẻ loi, **lovely** = đáng yêu, **manly** = nam tính; **silly** = ngớ ngẩn; **ugly** = xấu xí; **unlikely**: không có khả năng xảy ra; **monthly**: hàng tháng; **weekly**: hàng tuần, **brotherly** = như anh em; **comely** = duyên dáng; **goodly** = có duyên; **homely** = giản dị, **lowly** = hèn mọn, **masterly** = tài giỏi; **scholarly** uyên bác; **shapely** = dáng đẹp, **timely** = đúng lúc; **unseemly** = không phù hợp.
