✚ Usage (Cách dùng)

- Dùng để diễn tả một hành động, sự việc hoặc hiện tượng đang xảy ra tại thời điểm nói.
E.g. She **is dancing** at the moment.

✚ Signals (Dấu hiệu)

- Trong câu thường xuất hiện các từ: **now** (bây giờ); **right now** (ngay bây giờ); **at the moment** (vào lúc này); **at present** (hiện tại); **presently** (hiện tại); **currently** (hiện tại); **for the time being** (lúc này); **Look!** (nhìn kìa)

E.g. **Look!** He is doing his homework.

✚ How to add "-ing" to verbs

- Động từ kết thúc bằng một phụ âm và trước đó là nguyên âm duy nhất thì gấp đôi phụ âm cuối trước khi **thêm -ing**.
hit → hitting run → running
- Động từ có hai âm tiết mà âm tiết thứ hai kết thúc bằng một phụ âm và trước đó là một nguyên âm, và trong âm rơi vào âm tiết thứ hai thì gấp âm cuối trước khi **thêm -ing**.
admit → admitting begin → beginning
- Động từ kết thúc bằng **ie** thì **đổi ie thành y** rồi **thêm -ing**.
