The search for alternative sources of energy has led in various directions. Many communities are burning garbage and other biological waste products to produce electricity. Converting waste products to gases or oil is also an efficient way to dispose of waste.

Experimental work is being done to derive synthetic fuels from coal, oil shale, and coal tars. But today, that process has proven **expensive**. Other experiments are underway to harness power with giant windmills. Geothermal power, heat from the earth, is also being tested.

Some experts expect electrical companies to revive hydroelectric power derived from streams and rivers. Fifty years ago hydroelectric power provided one-third of the electricity used in the United States, but today **it** supplies only 4 percent. The oceans are another potential source of energy. One day Strauss saw that the miners needed strong clothes for work. He quickly took some of his canvas and made it into **pants**. These pants were very strong and lasted a long time. The pants became very popular immediately. Later Strauss wanted to make his pants even better, so **he** started making his pants from cotton cloth that was softer than canvas but just as strong. This fabric came from Nimes, a city in France, and was called “denim” (from de Nimes). Denim was popular in the fifteenth century. Christopher Columbus used denim for the sails of his ships. Sailors in Genoa, Italy, wore denim pants. The word “jeans” comes from the word “Genoa”. Mr. Strauss made the first jeans in the United States, but their name and their kind of cloth came from Italy and France.

The special years in Japan are 3, 5, and 7. These are the lucky years. On November 15 every year, there is a festival called “3-5-7” when the children and their families go to a religious place. Then the family gives a party for the child and gives the child gifts.
