Scientists have made significant progress in predicting natural disasters, which helps **minimize** the risks to people and property. Through research and technology, they can now predict earthquakes, hurricanes, floods, and volcanic eruptions, although the **accuracy** varies.

Earthquakes are difficult to predict because they occur suddenly and without warning. However, scientists use seismographs to monitor the Earth's movements. They track seismic activity to identify patterns and make predictions about areas where earthquakes are more likely.

Volcanic eruptions are predicted by studying gas emissions and earthquake activity near volcanoes. When there are unusual changes in these factors, scientists can warn nearby communities of a possible eruption.
