Riêng mẫu : Would / Do you mind + Ving.... ?(Nếu không có gì phiền , làm ơn...)

Đồng ý giúp thì nói:

Vế các câu trả lời ĐÔNG Ý thì hay dùng : Sure, Of course, còn không làm được thì luôn : Sorry

Riêng mẫu câu - **Would** / **Do you mind** + **Ving** " mind " ở đây mang nghĩa "phiền lòng" tức là hỏi người đó có phiền gì không khi giúp mình. Từ đó ta suy ra câu trả lời là : không (phiền)
