Sở hữu cách được dùng để diễn tả sự sở hữu của đối tượng thứ nhất với đối tượng theo sau bằng cách thêm 's vào sau đối tượng thứ nhất.

E.g: Daniel's book (sách của Daniel)

## 1. Cách dùng

(Giày của Jack thì không đắt.)

**E.g:** Their children's room is small.

**E.g:** There is a cup of coffee on the table.  
There is a stool next to the fireplace.
