4.3.2. Chiến thuật xử lý dạng câu hỏi này

 **Đọc và hiểu ngữ cảnh**

→ Đọc kỹ câu chứa từ/cụm từ đó, đồng thời xem xét một đến hai câu xung quanh để hiểu rõ ý nghĩa và sắc thái của từ trong ngữ cảnh cụ thể.

 **Xác định vị trí từ/cụm từ cần tìm**

→ Từ hoặc cụm từ này được in đậm trong đoạn văn → dễ dàng định vị nó trong bài đọc.

 **Loại bỏ và chọn đáp án phù hợp**

Sau khi nắm được nghĩa của từ, loại bỏ ngay những phương án không phù hợp:

Nếu đề yêu cầu tìm từ đồng nghĩa, **loại bỏ những từ mang nghĩa trái ngược**.

Nếu đề yêu cầu tìm từ trái nghĩa, **gạch bỏ những từ có nghĩa gần giống với từ trong bài**.

Lưu ý đến sắc thái nghĩa: Nếu từ trong bài có ý nghĩa tích cực, tránh chọn đáp án mang nghĩa tiêu cực, và ngược lại.

 **Lưu ý:**

Đôi khi, ta có thể hiểu hết nghĩa của từ/cụm từ được hỏi cũng như các đáp án cho sẵn. Tuy nhiên, **cần đọc kỹ ngữ cảnh trước khi chọn đáp án**, vì **một từ có thể mang nhiều nghĩa khác nhau tùy theo bối cảnh sử dụng**.

Ví dụ 1:

There are around 7,000 languages in the world today. However, most people speak the largest languages: Chinese, Spanish, English, Hindi, Russian, Arabic, and others. So what about the smaller languages? According to the UNESCO Atlas of the World's Languages in Danger, around one-third of the world's languages now have fewer than 1,000 speakers. We may soon lose those languages completely. In fact, 230 languages became **extinct** between 1950 and 2010.
