A great weekend



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Summary of Procedures

The usher introduces the child to the examiner. The examiner asks how old the child is.

- 1. The examiner asks the child to describe several differences between the *two Find the Differences* pictures, e.g. 'In picture 1, the house is blue but in picture 2, the house is red'.
- 2. The examiner tells the child the name of the story and describe the first picture, e.g. "Today is sunny. Emily and Lizzie go for a walk in the park.". The examiner then asks the child to continue to tell the story.
- 3. The examiner shows how to do the task with the first odd-one-out set of pictures. For example: 'These are all places. But this is a room in a house'. Then the examiner asks the child to choose one picture in the other three sets and say which is different and why.
- 4. The examiner asks questions about the child, e.g. "What did you do last weekend?"
