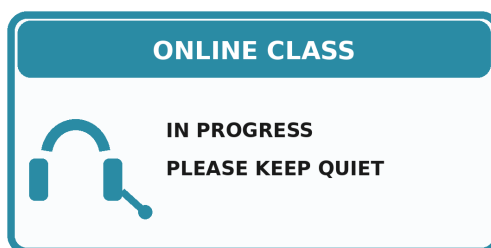

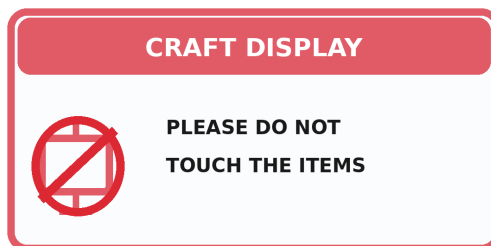

Hello, I'm Nam. Let me tell you about my daily lifestyle. On school days, I get up at six and usually have breakfast at a street-food stall near my house. I sometimes eat at home at weekends, but I do not normally have breakfast in the school canteen. At school, I greet my teachers by saying "Good morning, Mr Long" or "Good morning, Ms Hoa". I do not call them by their first names, and I never say only "Hi". After school, I help my parents and do my homework. I study English online twice a week, not every morning or just once a month. Technology is useful, but I also enjoy traditional activities. Next month, I will join a traditional craft club to learn how to weave small baskets. I am not moving to another country, and I certainly will not stop using technology. I like combining modern learning with traditional skills.

Students may feel lonely, become distracted by social media, or have problems with weak internet connections. In my opinion, online learning is very helpful when it is combined with face-to-face lessons and when students manage their screen time carefully.

Teacher note

- Question 34 is keyed as B because it is the only complete sequence offered in the test. For a future revision, “b – c – d – a” would also form a natural dialogue.
