



#### Grammar **Prepositions of movement**

We use prepositions of movement to describe how we move from one place to another place. They often go after a verb of movement (e.g., go, walk, run).

Here is a list of common prepositions of movement: to, towards, into / out of, across, over, through, along, up / down.

#### **Examples:**

We *climbed up* to the top of the Marble


